The NDFC is pleased to announce that Canada will be the host country for the 2013 WDF World Cup.

The bid was successfully presented at the WDF/World Cup conference in Charlotte North Carolina on September 23rd by Bill Hatter. Also in attendance at the meeting were Mary Dezan and Bob Gulliver. The bid was one of three on the agenda with Sweden deferring until 2015 and Turkey withdrawing following the Canadian bid presentation. There were 36 countries in attendance at the meeting.

The tentative dates will be October 2nd to October 5th 2013 in Saint John's Newfoundland with the Delta Hotel Saint John's being the venue for the complete event.
