



Lifetime Membership Award Criteria

The Lifetime Membership Award will recognise and promote individuals who have made a significant contribution to Darts in B.C. over a sustained period of time.

Eligibility

The Lifetime Membership Award is awarded to an individual who has:

- An established history with Darts In British Columbia,
- Made a lasting contribution to darts in the province,
- Exhibited leadership and/or provided inspiration to others,
- Positively influenced darts on a provincial, national or international level.

Nominees should have:

- Made a positive impact on darts at either provincial or national level,
- 15 years, or more, of sustained membership,
- Earned the respect of other dart players,
- Demonstrated, over an extended period of time, a contribution which has included any of the following: professional leadership, service to Darts in B.C., mentorship of youth players, represented B.C. at a provincial, national or international level,
- Personal integrity.

Process for nomination

Provide to the currently nominated president of Darts B.C. by email a short overview of the nominee, their achievements and the reason for the nomination.

Applicants will be assessed by the Darts B.C. executive against the following criteria,

- History of service
- Significant contribution and positive influence on darts in B.C.
- Leadership

Nominations should be received by January 15th each year, and awards will be announced at the AGM during provincial play downs.

Darts B.C. executive may decide, in any given year, to award any number of nominees a lifetime membership, or may also decide no viable candidates have been received.

Should a nominee not be selected there will be no limit to the number of times any member may be nominated.
