PROVINCIALS

Provincial Championship Location

The BC Provincial Championship shall be held annually, with the location of the event determined by a bidding and selection process.

Championship Site Inspection

In the case of a new venue not previously used for a Ranked Tournament or Provincial Championship, the proposed site for the Provincial Championship shall be inspected by a minimum of one Board Member, prior to receiving approval to host the event.

Championship Event Dates

The Provincial Championship shall be held over 3 days, on the BC Family Day Long Weekend.

Championship Categories & Allotments

Due to limitations in venue capacity and available equipment, participation will be restricted to approximately 80 men and 40 ladies. Registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Should the number of entries approach the maximum allowable based on available boards, registration may be closed without further notice to ensure the event can be conducted efficiently and within facility constraints. In the event that registration must be closed, a waitlist will be established, and players will be contacted if space becomes available. Every effort will be made to accommodate additional participants if resources and scheduling permit.

Provincial Championship Format

The Provincial Championship format shall consist of round robin play leading to a double knockout playoff.

Format of Play for the Women's Singles shall consist of:

- Round Robin 3 games for total points
- Knockout Round, up to and including the Semi-Finals Best of 5
- Finals Best of 7

Format of Play for the Men's Singles shall consist of:

- Round Robin 3 games for total points
- Knockout Round, up to and including the Semi-Finals Best of 7
- Finals Best of 9

The following formula shall be used for advancing from the round robin to the knockout:

- Under 32 players 8 sections of up to a maximum of 4 players with all players advancing to a 32-draw.
- 33 to 40 players 8 sections of up to a maximum of 5 players with all players advancing to a 32-draw.
- 41 to 48 players 8 sections of up to a maximum of 6 players with all players advancing to a 64-draw.
- 49 to 64 players 16 sections of up to a maximum of 4 players with all players advancing to a 64-draw.
- 65 to 80 players 16 sections of up to a maximum of 5 players with all players advancing to a 64-draw.

Each day of play shall be considered a separate event, and points will be awarded upon the completion of each day's event.

NDFC Rules of Play shall be in effect throughout all events.

The NDFC Dress Code shall be in effect throughout all events.

Points, for each day, shall be allocated as follows:

- 1st Place 25 points
- 2nd Place 22 points
- 3rd Place 19 points
- 4th Place 16 points
- 5th to 6th Place 13 points
- 7th to 8th Place 11 points
- 9th to 12th Place 9 points
- 13th to 16th Place 7 points
- 17th to 24th Place 5 points
- 25th to 32nd Place 4 points
- 33rd to 48th Place 3 points
- 49th to 64th Place –2 points
- 65th to 80th Place 1 point

The overall tournament results shall be based on the total of points earned by each player for each day of play.

Team BC shall consist of the top eight (8) men and the top eight (8) women, from the final results of the Provincial Championship.

Provincial Entry Fees and Registration

The registration fee for all entrants is \$200.00 per person.

Registration will be confirmed once both payments have been received, and membership has been validated.

All registrations must be submitted no later than one week prior to Provincials to be eligible to compete.

Seeding Principles

Initial seeding is based entirely on the DBCA Ranking List published prior to Provincials.

Only the Top 32 players will be seeded. Players ranked below the Top 32 will be randomly placed within sections. Seeds are arranged to ensure that higher-ranked players do not meet until the later rounds of knockout play.

Day 2 and Day 3 reseeding is based on results, with all ties broken according to the initial seeding rank.

TEAM BRITISH COLUMBIA

Player Agreement

Whenever a member has earned a place on Team British Columbia for the National Championship, that member shall be required to sign a "PLAYER AGREEMENT" outlining the responsibilities of both the team member and Darts BC, dress code requirements and what expenses are covered by Darts BC.

Team Selection

Team BC shall consist of the top eight men and top eight women, from the final results of the Provincial Championship.

Based on the finishing positions at the Provincial Championship, the representatives in the Men's Singles and Women's Singles Events must be submitted to the NDFC in the following order:

- Player 1: First Place
- Player 2: Second Place
- Player 3: Third Place
- Player 4: Fourth Place
- Player 5: Fifth Place
- Player 6: Sixth Place
- Player 7: Seventh Place
- Player 8: Eighth Place

Darts BC will be bringing an alternate (9th position), whose primary responsibility will be to support the Provincial Director at Nationals.

In the event that any team member is unable to attend the National Championship, that team member shall be replaced by the next available player, selected in order of their finishing position from the final results of the Provincial Championship.

In the event that team member is replaced prior to the Darts BC submission to the NDFC, each player shall move up in position for each event category. If the team member is replaced after the NDFC submission deadline, the replacement team member must take the position of the representative he or she is replacing in each event category, in accordance with NDFC Regulations.

The Men's Doubles Team and the Women's Doubles Team for the National Championships shall consist of:

- Team 1: Player 1 and Player 2
- Team 2: Player 3 and Player 4
- Team 3: Player 5 and Player 6
- Team 4: Player 7 and Player 8

The Mixed Doubles Team for the National Championships shall consist of:

- Team 1: Men's Player 1 and Women's Player 1
- Team 2: Men's Player 2 and Women's Player 2
- Team 3: Men's Player 3 and Women's Player 3
- Team 4: Men's Player 4 and Women's Player 4
- Team 5: Men's Player 5 and Women's Player 5
- Team 6: Men's Player 6 and Women's Player 6
- Team 7: Men's Player 7 and Women's Player 7
- Team 8: Men's Player 8 and Women's Player 8

Team Member Commitment Fee

All team members shall be required to pay a Team Member Commitment Fee when representing Darts BC at a National Championship.

Each team member will be required to submit their Team Member Commitment Fee, and signed Player Agreement by the established deadlines.
